



CERTIFIED HEALTH & SAFETY WORKER CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

The PSAI is dedicated to providing programs that promote high standards in a variety of areas ranging from service procedures to sales & marketing.

The PSAI Health & Safety Worker Certification Program is an impartial measure of a worker's competence and understanding of the sanitary and health requirements mandatory in the portable sanitation industry. The program sets the official standard of skills and knowledge for professionals in the industry and is part of the continuing professional education available from the Portable Sanitation Association International.

The purpose of this program is:

- To ensure that portable sanitation companies are operating at a specific standard of excellence.
- To improve the health, welfare, dignity and safety of both the customers served and those working in the industry.
- To provide minimum standards to regulatory agencies and legislative bodies in order to develop regulations surrounding the use of certified portable sanitation contractors.
- To ensure that the industry acts at all times to maintain and improve their operations for the protection of the environment.

The PSAI's Portable Sanitation Worker Certification is earned by completing the course of instruction and passing a written test of technical skills and industry knowledge and verifying work experience as a portable sanitation worker. To the public, this program is **one** impartial measure of a portable sanitation worker's competence and understanding of the sanitary and health requirements mandatory in this industry.

The PSAI Certification Board has established and implemented Company Requested Certification programs. This forum allows companies who want their Service Techs to upgrade their technical skill, but for whatever reason, are unable to attend the Certification Program at the Convention & Trade Show or the Nuts & Bolts Workshop.

To administer the Company Requested Certification program, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a PSAI certified worker of a PSAI member company
- Have at least three (3) years experience in the portable sanitation industry.
- Be serving in or previously served in a supervisory position within a portable sanitation industry.
- Be approved by the Certification Board.
